The principal of the school may approve a request to be absent from school conditioned on acceptable academic performance at the time of service as a trainee election worker.

Students ages 16 or 17 who are U.S. citizens in good academic standing at a Minnesota high school (or homeschooled) and who reside in the county or an adjacent county are eligible to be appointed as a student trainee election judge without party affiliation. Such a student may be excused from school during the hours that the student is serving as a student trainee election judge if the student submits this Permission Slip, signed by the student's parent or guardian, along with a certificate from the city clerk stating the hours that the student will serve, to the principal of the school at least 10 days prior to the election. (MN Statute 204B.19)
