

Washington County Career Pathways Program

What is it?

Career Pathways is a program designed to provide one-time grant support to eligible Washington County residents for **career enhancing activities**.

Support can be provided for:

- Finding a job, finding a better paying job, exploring new careers, and preventing unemployment
- Obtaining education and job training—certificates and licensure in your current job or a new role
- Finding and supporting internships—and more!



Who is Eligible? (Must meet all three)

- **Washington County Residents**
- **Household income requirements met—low or moderate income**
- **Authorized to work in the U.S.**

How can funds be used?

- **Short-Term Education Needs**—Tuition, Job Training, Certifications, Training Supplies
- **Employment Experiences**—Internships, Workshops, Tours, Mentorship Opportunities
- **Transportation Expenses**—Gas Cards, Transit Cards, Car Repairs, Insurance (Title and current driver's license required)
- **And More**—Childcare for Job Search/Training Activities, Employer Required Uniforms, Tools, Clothing for Job Interviews
